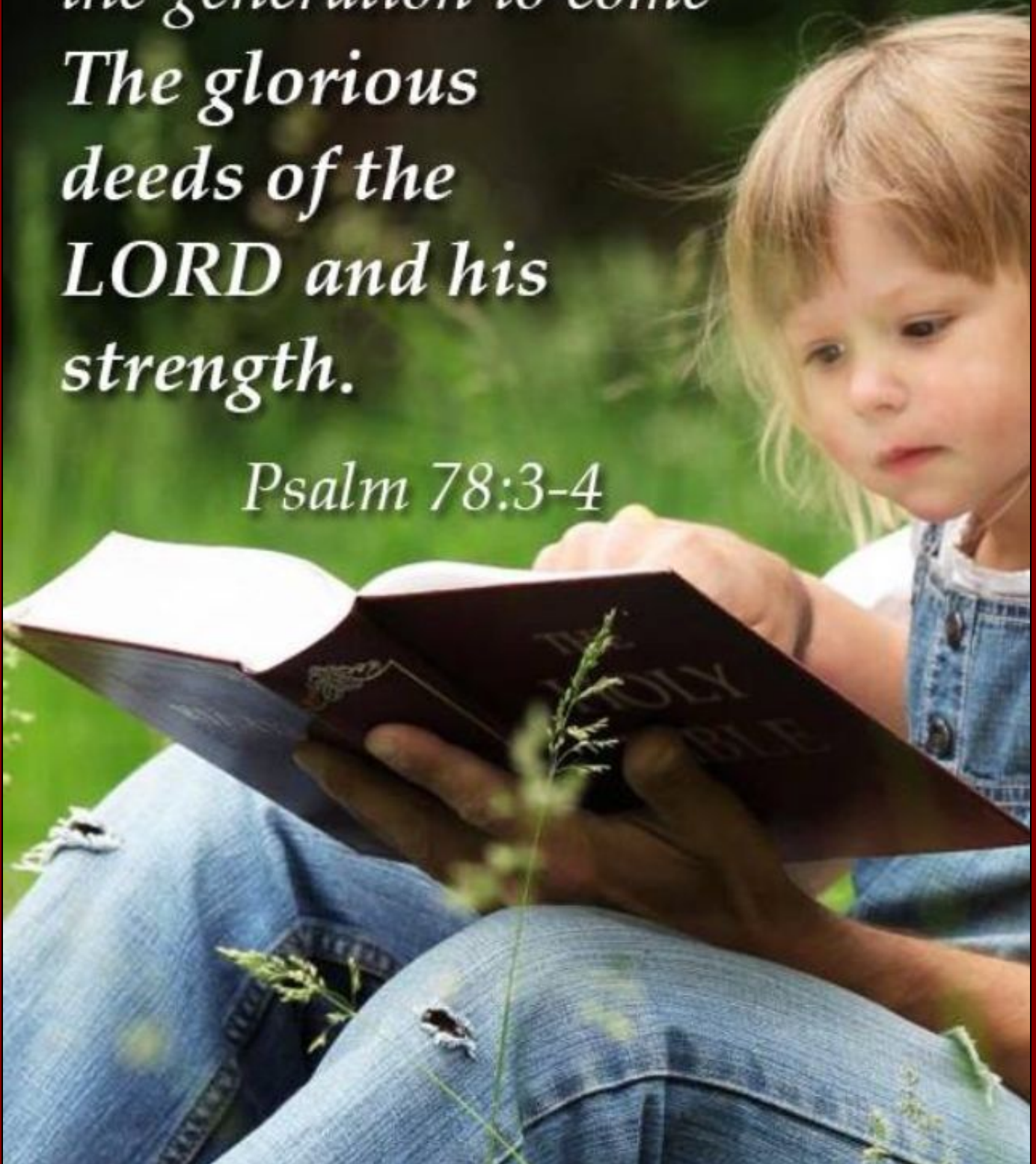

## We Will Tell The Next Generation
