I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. 4 Do not take a purse or bag or sandals; and do not greet anyone on the road.

5 "When you enter a house, first say, 'Peace to this house.' 6 If someone who promotes peace is there, your peace will rest on them; if not, it will return to you. 7 Stay there, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages. Do not move around from house to house. 8 "When you enter a town and are welcomed, eat what is offered to

you. 9 Heal the sick who are there and tell them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' 10 But when you enter a town and are not welcomed, go into its streets and say, 11 'Even the dust of your town we wipe from our feet as a warning to you. Yet be sure of this: The kingdom of God has come near.' 12 I tell you, it will be more bearable on that day for Sodom than for that town.

I have never thought of the words of this particular portion of scripture in context of the missionaries who are active in reaching people for Christ, but the implications are very clear. Those who are receptive to the words of Christ and message of God's love will realize the peace from God that goes well beyond peace on earth. The implications for those who reject not only the message, but also the messengers is almost more ominous with the promise of destruction that would even exceed the way Sodom was burned to the ground.

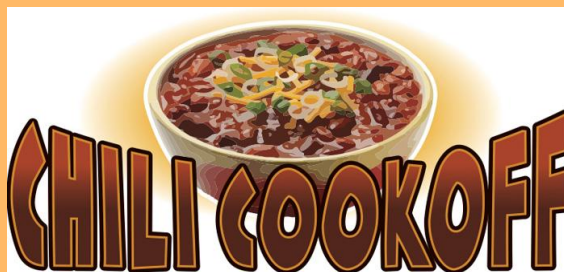
